

CASE STUDY – The Maryland State Bar Association is a non-profit professional organization that publishes legal practice guides and publications to keep the legal community up to date about changing laws within the state. Additionally, they advocate for their members on legislative policy being crafted by state lawmakers in Annapolis, as well as in Washington, D.C., when federal laws could have an impact on legal issues for the state.

WHAT THEY NEEDED – The association employs a relatively small staff and needed to be able to assign laborious tasks including tagging, layout, and composition to a third party. This would allow their editors to be further focused on providing author management, recruitment, and expert legal editing for the content their authors – practicing attorneys and judges who volunteer their time and legal expertise – write and update.

THE CHALLENGE – The Maryland State Bar Association needed to move to a more modernized software platform for their design and layout needs, along with improving their workflow and production capabilities. As a professional organization, they receive no funding from the state government, and are primarily reliant on membership dues to cover their operating costs.
